This can be paid for on Parent Pay and will cost £3 per child.

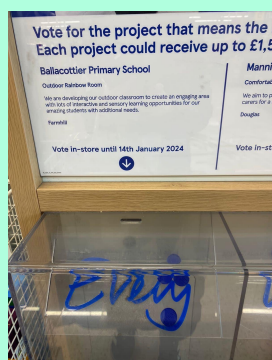
